Mozambique is home to over 32 million souls that have little to no access to the truth of God's word. We are asking the Lord to provide our needed support so that we can take the hope of salvation to this needy country!

Preparation and Ministry Plan:

The Lord has allowed my wife and I to serve in various ministry positions within our local church, I have received Bible training from Veritas Baptist College, and we have continued our missions preparation with Vision Baptist Missions as interns for 6 months.
